

Section 9 – FACILITY BASED SERVICES OFFERED IN AMERITECH & GTE AREAS

This section of the tariff contains a general description of the services offered by US Xchange d/b/a Choice One Communications and the rates applicable to each service. Choice One Communications provides switched, telephonic quality voice and data transmission services that enable Users to communicate on a real-time basis between point within a local calling area in the State, as well as ancillary services that facilitate the use or expand capabilities of switched communication services. Services provided to the Customer in the serviceable areas will be performed over the Company's own facilities. Services described in this section are available in all serviceable areas unless otherwise noted.

9.1 ChoiceXchange 2001

The service offerings and rates and charges contained in this tariff section 9.1 are discontinued to new customers. Existing customers subscribing to the service offerings prior to February 3, 2003 will continue to be supported and may add additional services as described under this section to their existing accounts. The Company reserves the right to revise rates for these service offerings.

9.1.1 Description of Services

ChoiceXchange encompasses all analog network access for business Customers. Customers with 2-wire connections using ground or loop start signaling will be offered a ChoiceXchange product. ChoiceXchange is available to business Customers only.

Choice Xchange provides a customer with a connection to the Company switching network which enables the Customer to:

- A) Receive calls from other stations on the public switched telephone network;
- B) Access the Company's Local Calling Service and other Services as set forth in this tariff;
- C) Access interexchange calling services of the Company and other carriers;
- D) Access the Company's operators and business office for service related assistance; access toll-free telecommunications services such as 800 NPA; and access 911 service for emergency calling.

Exchange areas and local calling areas are identical to those defined in the tariffs of the incumbent local exchange company servicing each exchange area.

9.1 ChoiceXchange 2001 (Cont'd)

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9.1.2 Application of Rates

A) Number of Lines

ChoiceXchange rates are based on the total number of lines existing to the location.

- Clients in Ameritech Serviceable Areas with less than five (5) lines will receive rates identified as 1-4 lines, between five (5) lines and ten (10) lines will receive rates listed as 5-10 lines, between eleven (11) lines and twenty (20) lines will receive rates listed as 11-20 lines, and clients with more than 20 lines (20) lines will receive rates listed as 21+ lines. All requests for measured lines will receive rates listed as measured.
- Clients in GTE Serviceable Areas with less than four (4) lines will receive rates identified as 1-3 lines, between four (4) lines and fifteen (15) lines will receive rates listed as 4-15 lines, between sixteen (16) lines and thirty (30) lines will receive rates listed as 16-30 lines, between thirty-one (31) lines and forty (40) lines will receive rates listed as 31-40 lines, and more than 40 lines (40) lines will receive rates listed as 41+ lines.

9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features

9.2.1 Description of Services

ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features described in this tariff section are available to business Customers only.

- A) Call Forward Variable (All Calls)
Customers can forward calls to another number. Calls can be forwarded to domestic, offshore, international or cellular numbers. The Customer manually enters the number to which calls will be forwarded. The Customer is billed any usage charges for the forwarded call. This feature can be activated and deactivated when needed. The Customer must be on premise to change the call forwarding number. The number cannot be changed from a remote location unless Call Forward Remote Access is purchased.
- B) Call Forward Busy Line
Customer designates the number that the line will be forwarded under the conditions of busy.
- C) Call Forward No Answer
Customer designates the number that the line will be forwarded under the conditions of no answer.
- D) Call Forward Busy Line/Don't Answer (fixed call forwarding)
Customer designates the number that the line will be forwarded under the conditions of busy or unanswered.
- E) Call Forwarding Remote Access
Allows the Customer to activate and deactivate Call Forwarding Variable from any location.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

- F) Three-Way Conference Calling
This feature allows the Customer to add a third party to an existing conversation utilizing a single line.
- G) Call Return (available as a pay per use product also)
Gives the Customer the number, date and time of the last incoming call, and will redial the number automatically or you can write down the number and call back later.
- H) Call Transfer
Gives the Customer the ability to transfer an incoming call to other phone destinations, both internally and externally. This feature includes Three-Way Conference Calling. If the number that you are attempting to transfer a call to is busy or there is no answer, press the receiver button again to connect with the first call. Additional charges may apply.
- I) Call Waiting
A short tone lets the Customer know someone else is calling while they are on the phone. The first call can be put on 'hold' to allow the second call to be answered. This feature gives the Customer the ability to handle more than one call at a time.
- J) Continuous Redial (available as a pay per use product also)
Automatically redials the most recent outgoing call, freeing the Customer to move on to other things, including using the phone for other calls.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

- K) Abbreviated Dialing
Allows a Customer to dial only the last four digits of a phone number that is associated with the Customer's location. This feature works between multiple locations of the same Customer if all locations are within the same lata.

- L) Call Intercept
Provides a recorded message informing the caller of a change in a telephone number. This service is free for one year or the life of the directory; whichever is longer.

- M) Direct Connect Line
Allows a local service line to automatically dial a designated number whenever the originating line goes off-hook. This feature is assigned to a phone, which is used only for one purpose.

- N) Ground Start
A type of central office signaling that can be provided as an option on local service trunks. Some types of telephone equipment, like selected lines on PBX systems, need ground start signaling to be able to receive dial tone from the central office.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

O) Hunting

All local telephone lines that are part of the same account and location can be set up to hunt at no additional charge. Hunting is available upon Customer request. Hunting allows calls to a line to rollover to the next available line in the group when the first line is busy. Customers can have more than one hunt group. Customers can also choose to leave individual lines out of a hunt group.

P) Caller ID

Displays both the originating name and number of an incoming call on a display unit provided by the Customer. Choice One does not provide the digital display box needed to use this feature. Some numbers may not display for a number of reasons, including:

- Calls placed through a long-distance carrier
- Calls from area where caller ID is not available
- Calls placed from cellular phones
- Calls from someone who has activated Caller ID blocking

Q) Caller ID Blocking – Per Use

Allows callers to block their name and number from being displayed on a caller ID unit at the terminating end of the call. There is no monthly charge or set-up fee for this feature, but if the Customer adds it after the line has been activated, a one-time charge applies. Call ID blocking is available on a per use basis for no additional charge.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

- R) Call Trace (pay per use product)
Allows the Customer to initiate a trace of the most recent incoming call immediately after terminating the call.
A complaint must be filed with the local law enforcement and an investigation requested. Call Trace request will be made available to the law enforcement agency upon its request.

- S) Speed Dial
Lets the Customer dial frequently called numbers faster using just a one-digit code. Each ChoiceXchange line can have its own individual list of speed dial numbers, up to maximum number of eight. Speed dialing can be programmed with domestic, offshore, Canadian and other international numbers if there are no toll restrictions on the line.

- T) Expanded Speed Dial
Lets the Customer dial frequently called numbers faster using a two-digit code. Each ChoiceXchange line can have its own individual list of speed dial numbers, up to maximum number of thirty. Speed dialing can be programmed with domestic, offshore, Canadian and other international numbers if there are no toll restrictions on the line.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

U) Fast Forwarding

Allows a Customer to obtain a phone number in one exchange and have all calls forwarded to another exchange. The Fast Forward number has no physical line associated with it.

The Fast Forwarding Interswitch is set up with five interswitch (city to city forwarding) paths. If the Customer will require the ability to have more than five calls come in at the same time to the number that is being fast-forwarded, the Customer will need to purchase additional paths (in blocks of 5 additional paths).

The Fast Forwarding Intraswitch (forwarding within the Choice One city switch) is set up with 99 intraswitch paths.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

U) Fast Forwarding (Cont'd)

Product Rules

Fast Forward Number (FFN) must be on the Choice One serviceable exchange list.

- Customer must choose a PIC for the line.
- No features may be attached to the FFN with the exception of voice mail.
- Customer can receive one yellow pages & white pages listing.
- Destination number can only be changed by calling into Customer Services.
- Destination number can not be 911, 611, x11, directory assistance or a feature code.
- Customer is charged for all usage to forward call to destination number. Caller only pays for call to FFN.
- The maximum number of sequential intra office forwardings is 99.
- A maximum of 5 calls can be forwarded at once. There will be an up charge for additional paths.
- Multiple FFN can be forwarded to the same destination number.
- Destination number can be intraLATA, interLATA, International, or Toll Free.
- If Customer has caller ID on destination number, the number of the calling party will appear on the call ID display, not the FFN number.
- Quality of data transmission on a FFN can not be assured.
- Destination number can not be a payphone.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

V) ChoiceXchange Blocking and Screening Services

1) 900 Blocking

900 Special Access Code Blocking Service is an optional service that provides Customers with the ability to block access from a particular network access line to all telephone numbers for which the 900 Special Access Code must be dialed.

2) 976 Blocking

976 Prefix Blocking Service is an optional service that provides Customers in Area Codes 312 and 708 with the ability to block access from a particular network access line to telephone numbers within their Area Code for which the prefix 976 must be dialed. Access from Company coin telephones, within MSA 1, to the 976 prefix will be blocked, except for calls made on a 0+ basis.

3) International Blocking

International Blocking Service is an optional service that provides blocking of international direct-dialed calls from business lines (1 MB – single and multi-line), Centrex lines, PBX trunks, and Customer-Owned Coin-Operated Telephone Service. International Blocking Service is offered where facilities permit. International Blocking Service blocks only DDD calls, not operator-assisted calls. International Blocking Service is only offered upon request.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

V) ChoiceXchange Blocking and Screening Services (Cont'd)

4) Toll Restriction

Screening of Operator-Assisted Calls is an optional service offered to business, COCOTS, and PBX carrier customers who wish to restrict outgoing operator-assisted calls to calling card, collect, and third number calls.

Call Screening/Selective Class is an optional service that blocks local outgoing, direct-dialed long distance, and sent-paid operator-handled calls. It allows the placement of calling card calls, collect calls, third number calls and 0+101XXXX calling.

5) Toll Billing Exception

Toll Billing Exception Blocking is an optional service that provides blocking of most collect calls and/or third number calls from being charged to an account. Third Party Blocking can block the following calls; both collect and third number calls, third number calls only, collect calls only.

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

V) ChoiceXchange Blocking and Screening Services (Cont'd)

6) Pay Per Use Blocking

- Automatic Callback Blocking
Automatic Callback Blocking is an optional per line service that provides customers with the ability to block the use of Auto Callback on a per use function (*69).
- Three Way Conference Call Blocking
Three Way Conference Call Blocking is an optional per line service that blocks the activation of per use Three Way Conference Calling on a line.
- Repeat Dialing Blocking
Repeat Dialing Blocking is an optional per line service that blocks the activation of per use Repeat Dialing on a line.

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9.2 ChoiceXchange A La Carte Features (Cont'd)

9.2.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

- W) Call Waiting with Caller ID
Enhances the Caller ID and Call Waiting features. Provides the Customer with the name and/or number of another incoming call while the Customer already has one call in progress. The name and/or number is displayed on the incoming call after the first sending call waiting tone. Customer's handset must support Call Waiting with Caller ID.

- X) Distinctive Ring
Allows the Customer to have multiple Dialed Numbers ("DN") on a single line. Each DN has a unique ringing pattern and does not require additional line terminations. Only 2 DNs may be assigned to a line and only 2 ring types (patterns) are available. DNs must be from the same rate center.

- Y) Group Call Pick-up
Enables the Customer to answer a call that has terminated to another user's station in the defined Call Pick-up Group ("CPU Group"). A call pick-up is accomplished by dialing a pick-up access code while the called station is ringing. If more than one station in the group is ringing, the station that has been ringing the longest will be intercepted first.

The service offerings and rates and charges contained in this tariff section 9.3 are discontinued to new customers. Existing customers subscribing to the service offerings prior to February 3, 2003 will continue to be supported and may add additional services as described under this section to their existing accounts. The Company reserves the right to revise rates for these service offerings.

ChoicePath Products are available to business Customers only.

9.3.1 ChoicePath

9.3.1.1 Description of Services

T-1 Facility is a high capacity dedicated leased line circuit consisting of 24 channels for voice and data transmission. It utilizes high speed, digital telecommunications technology at a transmission path of 1.544 Mbps.

T-1 service is available on a full capacity basis (24 channels) or on an individual channel basis with up to 24 channels of capacity available. A minimum block of 10 channels (DS0s) are required to purchase ChoicePath service.

ChoicePath is designed for Customers utilizing their own internal telephone switching system known as a private branch exchange (PBX).

Channel Configuration (per channel)

- DID (Direct Inward Dialing) - DID provides one way inbound calling only terminating directly to a PBX station.
- DOD(Direct Outward Dialing) - DOD provides for one way outbound calling only. Outbound Long distance calls will follow the CIC of the trunk group, not the individual trunks.
- DID/DOD - This service allows for both inbound and outbound calling. Outbound long distance calls will follow the PIC of the trunk group, not the individual trunks. This service is also referred to as two-way or combination trunks.

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9.3 ChoicePath Products 2001 (Cont'd)

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9.3.1 ChoicePath (Cont'd)

9.3.1.1 Description of Services (Cont'd)

Applications - The ChoicePath product serves the following applications:

- Digital DID/DOD Trunks directly into a Customer's PBX via a DTI card.
- Digital DID/DOD Trunks provided over a T1 that terminates in a Customer provided channel bank and connects to the PBX via analog connections.

The T1 facility is identified by a circuit ID for purposes of repair or service related issues. T1 service may be provisioned to support multiple trunk groups and/or line circuits. A trunk group consists of DS0s that may or may not physically be carried on the same T1. Associated with each trunk group or line circuit is a billing telephone number (BTN). The BTN is used to bill usage charges associated with local and or long distance calls carried over the individual DS0s.

DID Blocks

Direct Inward Dial (DID) service is designed to provide a block of telephone numbers (10 numbers per block) used for accepting incoming calls into a location's PBX.

9.3.1.2 Application of Rates

A) Term Offerings

Choice One offers additional savings to the Customer based on commitment levels of MTM through 60-month service agreements (offered in 12-month increments).

B) InfiniteChoice

One, two, and three product offerings - In addition to term discounts, ChoicePath has different pricing based on number of services selected.

- A one-product offering consists of rates based on ChoicePath service only.
- A two-product rate would consist of a combination of any two services including ChoicePath plus either long distance services or data.
- A three-product rate would consist of ChoicePath, long distance and data. Data consists of either DSL access or dedicated Internet Access.

C) Surcharges

The following surcharges will be assessed for ChoicePath:

- End User Common Line Charge (EUCL) - This is a monthly charge that is billed in advance to the T1 connection.
- E911 Service Surcharge - The rate assessed is based on per county defined costs to provide service to all active voice channels.
- Dual Party Relay Service Surcharge - USX assesses a per channel charge to help recover the cost of providing this service.

9.3.2 ChoicePath PRI

9.3.2.1 Description of Services

PRI connections are provisioned via a 1.544 T1 facility and consist of 23 B (voice) channels and 1 D (data) channels or 24 B channels. The D channel is a 64kilobit (Kbps) channel that carries signaling and control for the B channels. The D channel allows features that require data information such as Caller ID to be used on a T1.

PRI is able to offer services such as Direct Inward Dialing (DID), Direct Outward Dialing (DOD), and combination DID/DOD. ChoicePath PRI allows Customer-provided Digital PBX equipment to interface with the company's switch for voice traffic.

PRI Types Available:

- Custom PRI with FAS (Facility Associated Signaling) - This is 1 D channel for signaling and 23B channels for voice. Supports older PBX configurations
- National PRI (NI2) with FAS - This is 1D channel for signaling and 23B channels for voice. National Standard version 2.
- National PRI (NI2) with NFAS (Non Facility Associated Signaling) - This is 1D channel for signaling with up to 479B channels. National Standard version 2.

T-1 service is available on an individual channel basis with up to 24 channels of capacity available. For voice only T-1 service, a minimum of 15 channels must be purchased. For integrated voice and data T-1 service (both services over the same T-1 facility), a minimum of 10 channels must be purchased. Data only T-1 facilities do not have a channel minimum.

Choice Path is designed for Customers utilizing their own internal telephone switching system known as a private branch exchange (PBX).

Voice Channel Configuration (per channel)

- DID (Direct Inward Dialing) - DID provides one way inbound calling only terminating directly to a PBX station.
- DOD (Direct Outward Dialing) - DOD provides for one way outbound calling only. Outbound long distance calls will follow the CIC of the trunk group, not the individual trunks.
- DID/DOD - This service allows for both inbound and outbound calling. Outbound long distance calls will follow the PIC of the trunk group, not the individual trunks. This service is also referred to as two-way or combination trunks.

All such lines must be set up with zero call packs.

* Advantage Unlimited applies to all domestic toll usage generated by the Customer, including interexchange toll traffic that would be subject to the terms and conditions of the Company’s applicable interexchange tariff(s).

9.9 Office to Office Calling Plan

9.9.1 Description of Services

The Office to Office Calling Plan is a per line feature that enables customers to place calls between locations served under the same account without incurring usage sensitive charges. The following conditions will apply to Office to Office Calling:

1. This feature is available to multiple service locations billed under one account number.
2. The feature is offered on a per line basis for telephone numbers that are billed under the same account.
3. Office to Office Calling is available on ChoiceXchange lines and ChoicePath lines and trunks.
4. The maximum per line toll usage for Office to Office Calling is 200 minutes. Toll usage exceeding this threshold will be billed at the applicable usage rates. The usage cap will be aggregated for all lines with Office to Office Calling at a single location. Toll usage includes local toll and interexchange usage combined.
5. For ChoiceXchange lines, the Company does not require that all lines within a service location subscribe to the Office to Office Calling feature, but only those lines that carry the Office to Office Calling feature will be eligible for the Office to Office Calling benefits. For ChoicePath lines and trunks, if the customer subscribes to the Office to Office Calling feature, the Company does require that all lines within a service location subscribe to that feature.

7. Usage charges will apply to toll calls that are made via casual ("10XXX") dialing.
8. Office to Office Calling applies only to station to station voice calling.
9. Certain custom calling features may not be available to customers subscribing to Office to Office Calling.
10. Office to Office Calling may be unavailable in situations where the lack of suitable Company facilities make the provisioning of such service technically infeasible. Office to Office Calling may, in certain situations, also be unavailable due to the limitations of the customer's equipment or compatibility problems that exist between the customer's equipment and the facilities of the Company. Office to Office Calling is only available on facility-based lines, not on UNE-P.
11. Usage placed from a line carrying the Office to Office feature to another eligible intracompany terminating line will not be included in any bundled rate plans.

Note: The Office to Office Calling feature will also be available for interexchange, interLATA toll calls placed between locations billed under the same account. See the applicable Company tariffs.

9.11 Ultra T-1 Product Set

9.11.1 Description of Services

The Ultra T-1 Product Set consists of voice, Internet and data services provided to the Customer's service location via a T-1 Facility. The Ultra T-1 Product Set is available to business Customers only.

Customers will have the option of selecting one of five types on T-1 circuits:

- Dedicated Voice Full
- Dedicated Voice Fractional
- Integrated Voice, Internet and Data Point to Point (two or more services on the same T-1 circuit)
- Dedicated Internet
- Full Point to Point

T-1 service is available on an individual channel basis with up to 24 channels of capacity available. The minimums for the different types of Ultra T-1 products are as follows:

- Dedicated Voice Full: 24 channel minimum
- Dedicated Voice Fractional: 16 channel minimum
- Integrated Voice, Internet and Data Point to Point: must purchase at least two of the foregoing services to qualify and at least four channels for each service selected; 16 channel minimum

9.11.4 ISDN PRI Option

A) Description of Services

The ISDN PRI Option (D channel) may be added to any voice circuit meeting that product's minimum requirements. The D channel is a 64kilobit (Kbps) channel that carries signaling and control for the B channels (all other channels on that circuit). The D channel allows features that require data information such as Caller ID to be used on a T-1.

ISDN PRI allows for services such as Direct Inward Dialing (DID), Direct Outward Dialing (DOD), and combination DID/DOD.
